GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **DDs Adm / Sports Officers.** Every Principal of school will ensure the implementation of these instructions through respective DD Adm and Coord, where there is no DD Adm and Coord, the head of the school / institute will nominate a sports officer.

DD Adm & Coord / Sports Officers of schools will ensure the following:-

- a. Plan and organize daily sports at School level.
- b. Allocation of sports facilities to students during sports period in coordination with Sports Branch.
- c. Prepare detailed plans of respective schools based upon the "NUST & HEC Annual Sports Schedule.
- d. Establish a student sports committee of respective school comprising one student from each semester. The said committee will function under DD Adm/Sports officer of the school and coordinate all sports activities.
- e. Discipline and control of their students and personnel involved in sports.
- f. Use of proper sports dress / kit and turnout of the teams during Intra Campus sports.
- g. Short listing / selecting good players for NUST Campus / University team.
- h. Submit the list of their teams to DD Sports NUST as per given date/schedule.
- i. Any additional task assigned by Sports Branch.
- j. All Final competitions will be witnessed by the Principals of the playing teams.

2. All schools will prepare the following no of teams for all team events competitions keeping in view their student's strengths: -

Ser	Students strength of school	No of Teams
1.	Upto 500	1
2.	501 – 1000	2
3.	1001 above	3

3. A student is allowed to participate in only two games of team event competitions but can participate in any no of individual games like Tennis, Table Tennis, Squash etc. However, participation in more than two sports is allowed in Inter Campus and above competitions.

- a. Participation of one PG student is compulsory in each game of team events.
- b. Ensure that each individual takes part in Sports.
- c. Encourage faculty and staff to take part in daily sports. Each school should prepare a team comprising faculty and staff (50% each) for all faculty / staff sports competitions.

4. Any individual student planning sports activities must coordinate with Sports Branch through respective School's sports officer for availability of sports facilities well in advance.
5. Booking of facilities for organizations/community outside NUST, indoor Gymnasium will be booked between 0900hrs - 1700hrs while outdoor facilities will be booked from 0900hrs to 2100hrs. (booking will be made subject to availability of facility)
6. All organizing and participating schools shall extend full cooperation to Sports Branch, to make the event / championship a success.
