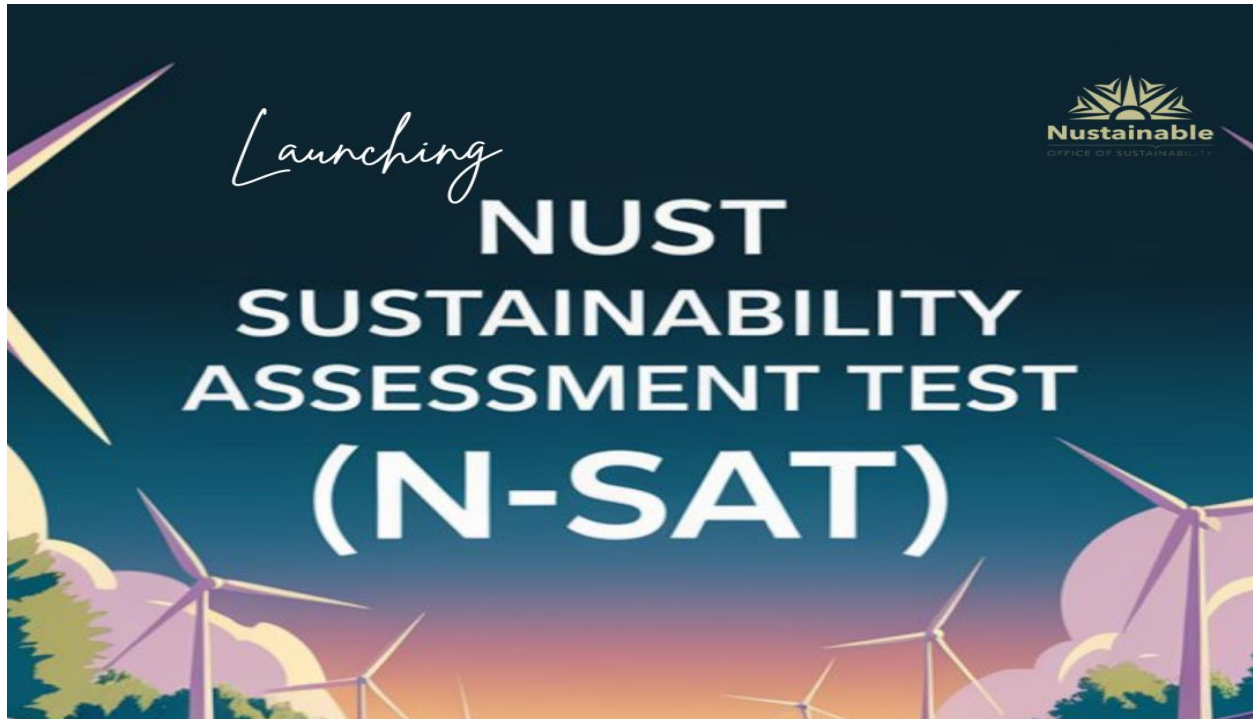


NUST Launches the Sustainability Assessment Test (N-SAT) for CSL Students

- Climate action, ethical governance, and resource efficiency principles

N-SAT is inspired by the globally recognized Sulitest, a respected tool for assessing sustainability knowledge worldwide. However, NUST's version is uniquely contextualized for Pakistani students and designed to reflect the challenges, opportunities, and responsibilities they will face in their communities and future professions.
